

School-Wide Learning Goals (SWLGs) - Inter-Lakes High School's SWLGs are Critical Thinking (CT), Effective Communication (EC) and Responsible, Respectful Behavior (RR). The SWLGs are assessed at least once by each teacher in each course and are reported out in the students' standards report card. The rubrics for the assessment of the school-wide learning goals are in the student handbook and on the high school web page. The ratings for SWLGs are O (Outstanding), P (Proficient), B (Beginning) and D (Developing.)

Inter-Lakes High School's SWLGs are closely linked to the College and Career Readiness skills that are the basis of the Common Core State Standards. Students will be best prepared for college and career by consistently scoring in the proficient and above range on the SWLGs by junior and senior year.

Grade Point Average (GPA) -

A student's GPA is calculated by multiplying the weighted point value of the grade by the credit of the course.

Point values are listed below and are weighted one full point for honors and AP level courses.

A+ = 4.333, A = 4.0, A- = 3.667 B+ = 3.333, B = 3.0, B- = 2.667
 C+ = 2.333, C = 2.0, C- = 1.667 D+ = 1.333, D = 1.0, D- = .667 F-0

There are two different types of GPA listed on report cards - term GPA and cumulative GPA.

Term GPA is calculated by multiplying the grade by the portion of the credit that has been earned at that point in time. For the first and third marking period, the points of a semester course grade are multiplied by HALF of the credit weight since the course is only HALF completed. The pro-rated credits for quarter classes (.5 credits) is .5 because the class is completely finished. For year long courses, the GPA is multiplied by .25 for first quarter, .50 for second quarter and .75 for third quarter.

Term GPA is used to determine Honor Roll status.

As an example, the term GPA for first quarter grades is calculated as shown below:

Career GPA is calculated in the same manner as term GPA but only includes the grades for courses that have been completed.
